

Liaocheng University



- Liaocheng University is located at Liaocheng City, a national historical and cultural city known as the “Water City North of the Yangtze River” in China.
- LU now has 27 colleges, 87 undergraduate degree programs, 93 master degree programs. The undergraduate degree programs include, but are not limited to, philosophy, economics, law, pedagogy, literature, history, science, engineering, agriculture, management and medicine. Now there are 32,000 full-time students and 2,100 full-time faculty members at LU.
- LU's two campuses cover a total area of 200 hectares with a building area of 750,000 m². The total value of laboratory apparatus and equipments is RMB240 million Yuan. Its libraries possess a collection of books up to 2,500,000 volumes and hundreds of TB electronic books and journals. With its picturesque lakes and evergreens -- together with many modern teaching facilities, lab buildings, libraries, web centers, and gymnasiums -- the campus creates an elegant environment uniquely suited for study and research.
- LU has always attached much importance to international exchange and cooperation. Now it has established collaborative relationship with more than 100 colleges and universities in over 40 countries and regions.

Brief Introduction to Liaocheng

- *Liaocheng was named the "pivot of the Canal" and the "famous city in the regions north of the Yangtze River" in history. Liaocheng is located in the west of Shandong Province with Mount Tai and Confucius Temple as its close neighbors. Liaocheng is also well-known as the "Water City North of the Yangtze River" as well as "a Capital City in Ancient China along the The Grand Beijing-Hangzhou Canal". The Grand Canal runs through the city. It is only about a one-hour drive from Jinan International Airport, and four hours by train to Beijing.*

- *Now there are more than 400 historical and cultural sites in Liaocheng, including Dongchang Lake, Grand Canal, Guangyue Tower, Shanshan Guild Hall, Jingyanggang Hill, Haiyuange Library of Qing Dynasty, and other well-known places.*

- *City structure of Liaocheng: "City in a lake, and lake in a city". The ancient city is a 1-km² square, surrounded by Dongchang Lake, which is the largest man-made in-city lake in north China, and whose total water area is a bit larger than that of West Lake in Hangzhou, China.*

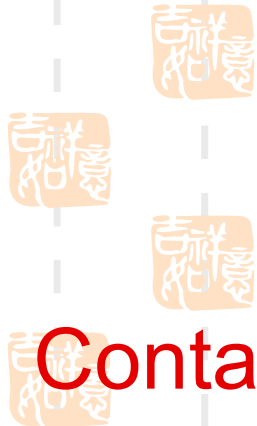
